From the South

As our journey in Freemasonry began in a room contiguous to King Salomon's Temple, symbol of self-development, and spiritual sustenance, I would like to address the importance of the Hebrew alphabet. Without deepening into Biblical accounts, the language of the temple builders was Hebrew with twenty-two letters. Why is Hebrew so important to initiates?

While there are 70 major languages, there are more than 3 thousand languages excluding dialects. Among all languages, according to the cabalists, only one alphabet is divinely created: Hebrew. Its letters are not only multifaceted, but each one is imbued with divine energy and carries specific Gematria. For example, the first letter Alef is equivalent to 1. When probing this first letter, it reveals a deeper mystery. *Aleph* is made of 3 letters, which are *vav* with a numerical value of 6 and two *yod* (10 each) totaling 26. This is just one example out of many to support the importance of **G**ematria in Freemasonry.

The Hebrew alphabet is indispensable in our understanding of the Tree of Life. 22 letters plus the 10 Sefirot total 32, which has the same meaning of the word heart represented by *lamed* and *beta*, the first and last letter of the Torah (5 books of Law written by Moses). What was King Salomon greatest desire from his heart to God? Wisdom. There are 32 paths of wisdom, which are private, personal paths as per the meaning of the Hebrew word *Netivot*. Wisdom is a sefira represented by *Chakhmah*.

According to Sefer Yetzirah, 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet are divided into: 3 Mothers, 7 doubles, and 12 elementals. The 3 Mothers represent 3 columns of the cabbalistic Tree of Life. On the right is the letter *mem* headed by wisdom paralleling water; the middle column is *aleph*, paralleling air in the sefira keter or crown; the left column represents *Binah*, fire represented by the letter *shim*. The 7 doubles are the seven Hebrew letters that carry both a soft and a hard sound and they parallel the 7 planets, the 7 days of the week, the 7 arts. Speaking of the number 7, we freemasons, interested in High Sciences know that there are 7 hearts in the brain and 7 brains in the heart, according to Mainly P. Hall.

Bothers, I wanted to summarize the importance of the Hebrew alphabet, in our quest to self-development. These divine letters were engraved, carved, weighed, permuted and transformed to create everything that has been and will be created by God. Each brother, in due time and armed with proper knowledge, can permute the Hebrew letters, during propitious planetary hours to obtain what his heart desires and/or to reach higher level of consciousness. The philosophy of Freemasonry on a deeper level is of great interest. Education is as important as brotherly love, maybe more for some. Reclaiming traditions to the best of our abilities is imperative.
